

Fire Dept;

A little history on our fire department, the Winfield Township Volunteer Fire Department was established in 1947 and it was decided to change the

name to Amble Volunteer Fire Department sometime in the 1980's. The Amble Volunteer Fire Dept. covers all of Winfield Township, which is 36 square miles. They have a class 1 pumper, a 2000-gallon tanker and two DNR grass trucks. They have room for more volunteers. They have meetings the first Thursday of every month at 7pm. We must again bring to your attention Michigan State Laws on Boating.

All registrations must be up to date as the Sheriff can ticket you. State Law says all Personal watercrafts must be off the water ONE Hour prior to sunset.

All motorized watercrafts must:

- 1. Go Counterclockwise
- 2. Stay 100 feet from docks and other boats.
- 3. Must have spotters when towing skiers /tubers
- 4. Obey "NO WAKE" areas.
- 5. Our "NO WAKE" hours are 8:30pm to 11:00am.


