Abbott Pavilion Rental:



There is a flat \$50 rental fee payable to the Lake Shores Association plus a separate \$50 cleaning deposit payable to Angela Ringler for the use of the pavilion. Dues must be current for members to able to rent the pavilion. The pavilion can be reserved for your personal event by completing and submitting the Pavilion Rental form on our website or contacting Angela Ringler at 231-580-9526. The two separate deposits (rental and cleaning) must be paid to the treasurer when you make your reservation. Deposits will be refunded only if your reservation is canceled at least

one month in advance of the date you had reserved to use the pavilion.

Please note that the cleaning deposit will be forfeited if fasteners such as tape, nails, wires, paperclips, and screws are used to attach items to walls, ceiling, or windows. Smoking is not allowed in the pavilion – smoking in the pavilion will also result in the forfeiture of the cleaning deposit.

Fish:


More walleye and crappie were planted in our lake last October. There were 400 6 to 9 inch Walleye and 780 Black Crappie planted last fall. The total fish plant budget for 2012 was \$4000

Architectural Committee:

Building regulations are spelled out in LSA covenants, restrictions and township zoning ordnance. All structures and alterations must get approval and/or permits from LSA architectural committee, township zoning administrator, and county building department.

Break-ins:

Just beware, incidents of break-ins around the lake, and there have been theft of gas tanks and boat batteries already reported. Prowlers have also been reported this winter. Also this winter, Snowmobiles have been driven across yards, damaging flowers and turf. Be respectful and stay off private property.

Vice President's report:

Docks

Members that have docks in the common areas must remember to pay their annual assessments by April 1. That will insure that they can keep their current dock and dock location. Members with docks in the common areas could loose their dock and/or their current dock location if their annual assessments are not received on time.

Trash

Ice fisherman have noticed a lot of trash left on the lake by other ice-fisherman. Members are encouraged to help maintain the ice as well as open water free of trash. Also lake members are responsible for guests they bring to the lake.

Renters - reminder to LSA members when they rent out their Indian Lake property.

Only owners may use common properties as defined in the Covenants and Restrictions. Conversely, renters may not use these common properties. Renters of lots in the association can access the lake by means other than common properties; however, Winfield Township has enacted an anti-funneling ordnance that would, in effect, prohibit member lakefront owners from giving non-owners access to our lake across their property.
