Independence Day Celebration

We will celebrate the holiday on July 3rd (if it rains, we'll delay everything until the fourth).

Review of the Boating Rules:

Enclosed is a 100' brochure. **READ IT and KEEP IT.** A quick review: New laws for wave runners – you must be over 150' behind any other boat. Remember wave runners; do not play in the same place too long. You may love your wave runner (I love mine) but others may not. For everyone – 100 feet off the shore. **Everyone is to go counter clockwise at all times – you absolutely can not cut straight across the lake.** You must follow the circle (this includes pontoons – no matter your speed the rule still applies). Lake hours – before 11 AM and after 9 PM is no wake time. This time is set aside for fishermen and sightseers. It is not appropriate to fly over to a fishing spot full throttle and then fish – it's no wake time for all.

Warrior Island Backfill

We will be backfilling the island on the fourth of July weekend. Please call Terry Veneklase to sign up for a 2 hour time block 937-6251. It takes two people at a time to run the pumps one to hold the hose in the sand in the lake and one to hold the hose where
